

**INVITATION TO APPLY FOR 2010 VALUE ADJUSTMENT BOARD:
APPRAISER SPECIAL MAGISTRATE

The Value Adjustment Board of Walton County, Florida, invites appraisers and attorneys who are licensed in the State of Florida and meet the following criteria to submit their Letter of Interest to serve as Appraiser Special Magistrate, Tangible Personal Property Magistrate, Attorney Special Magistrate, or VAB Attorney:

- 1. Applicant may not be an elected or appointed official or an employee of Walton County, any taxing jurisdiction or the State of Florida.**
- 2. Tangible Personal Property APPRAISER Special Magistrate must be a designated member of a professionally recognized appraiser's organization in the State of Florida with not less than five (5) years experience in tangible personal property valuation.**
- 3. Real Estate APPRAISER Special Magistrate must be a state certified real estate appraiser with no less than five (5) years experience in real property valuation.**
- 4. ATTORNEY Special Magistrate and VAB Attorney must be a member in good standing of The Florida Bar and have no less than five (5) years experience in the area of ad valorem taxation and must not represent any taxing authority.**
- 5. No Special Magistrate may represent a person before the Value Adjustment Board in any tax year during which he/she serves as a Special Magistrate.**

The Walton County Value Adjustment Board invites qualified appraisers and attorneys to submit proposals including their proposed hourly fee and all qualifying documents to the following address NO LATER THAN AUGUST 27, 2010 at 4:30 P.M. Please make sure all qualifications, supporting documents, and work experience is documented in your Letter of Interest. Letters of Interest received after the deadline will not be eligible.
